

## "I Spy" Bag

### **Preparation:**

Cut 2 fleece squares that are 6" x 6". On one piece of the fleece, place a ruler diagonally from one corner to the other. Make a small dot at the 2 ¼" mark. Continue around the edge of the fleece until you have 4 dots. Draw a line from dot to dot, forming a 3" square. Carefully cut along the lines to form the window for the bag.

You will need a 4" square piece of vinyl for the window. I recommend a thickness of 4 mil or more to give durability to the finished product. You also need a 6" piece of ¼" ribbon.

### **Construction:**

Center the vinyl over the cut out window. Put a small piece of scotch tape on the corners of the vinyl, keeping the fabric straight. Fleece is very stretchy so it is easy to twist the shape of the bag. Make sure everything is as straight as possible. Place the fabric side down under the pressure foot of the sewing machine.

Vinyl will stick to metal, so as you are sewing, make sure you do NOT press the vinyl to the plate through the window opening. The vinyl can also stick to the pressure foot causing distortion as you sew. To prevent this, lower the needle to the starting point then moisten the vinyl from under the foot all along one edge. This can be done with a sponge or damp cloth or a wet finger! Carefully sew around all four edges of the window with either a straight or zigzag stitch. Make sure the stitching is very close to the edge of the window.

Next, pin the bag together with the window on the outside. Pin the piece of ribbon near one of the corners between the fabric pieces. Carefully sew around the bag, making a seam of about ¼" to ½". Leave an opening on one side of the bag. Make sure you catch the ribbon in only one seam of the bag. Do not clip the corners or trim the seams. Turn the bag right side out. It is ready to be filled.

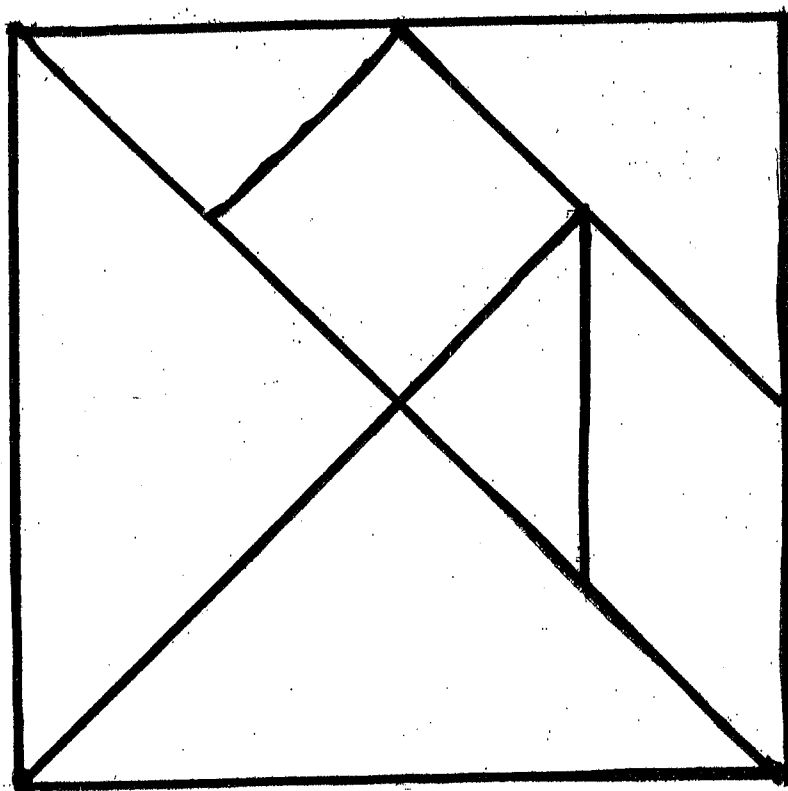
### **Filling:**

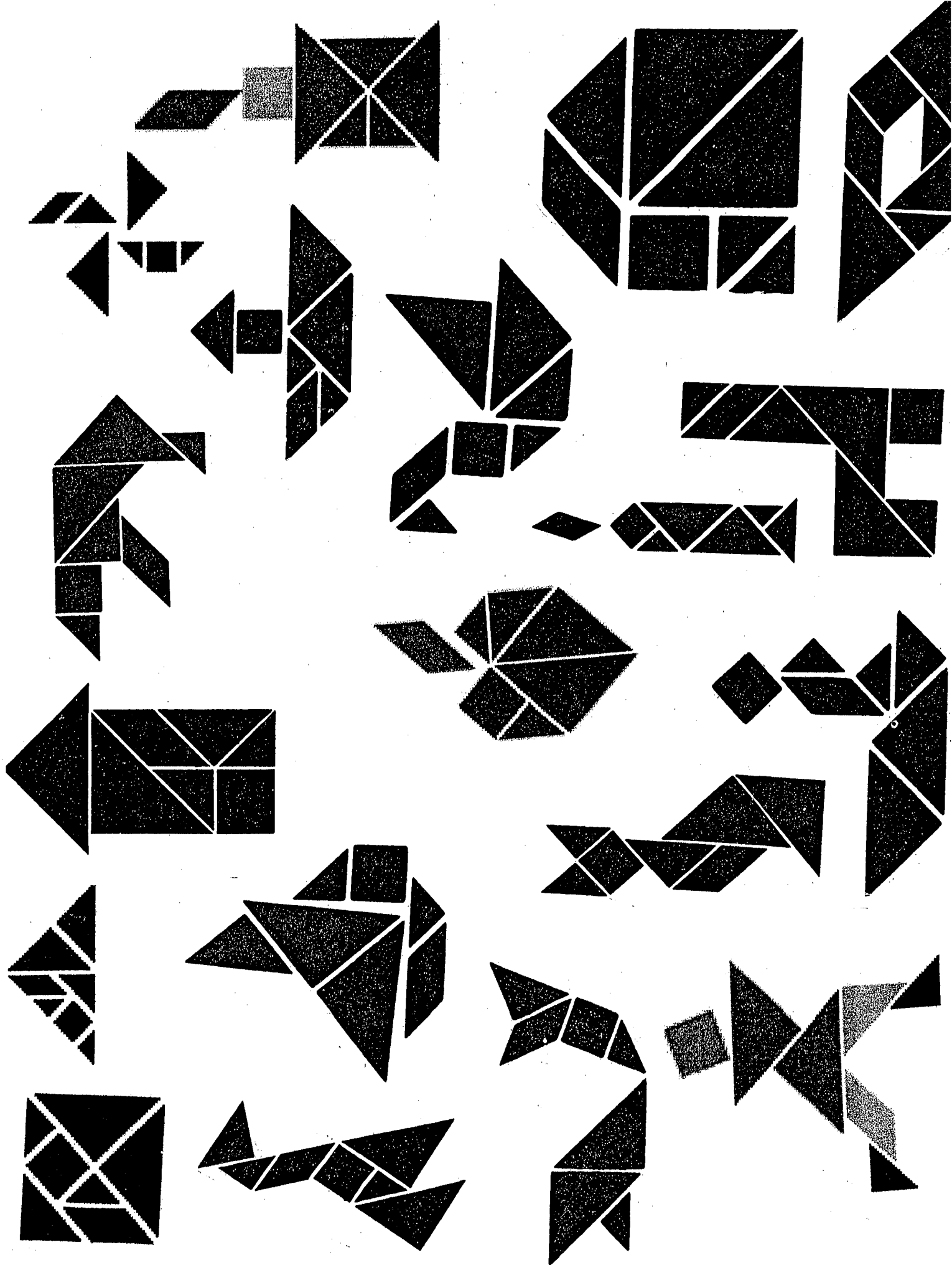
You will need about 1 cup of Poly-Pellets and an assortment of small objects to fill your bag. The Poly-Pellets can be found in craft stores, fabric stores or Wal-Mart in the doll making section. They are used as stuffing for dolls. The small objects can include things like a paper clip, a button, an elastic band, a penny, etc. Craft stores have sections of novelty buttons, sequins, etc. that could also be used. Choose about 20 objects and place them inside the bag. Insert a funnel into the opening. Carefully and slowly pour the Poly-Pellets into the funnel. Gently remove the funnel and shake everything to the bottom of the bag, Turn the edge of the opening to the inside, Using a whip stitch, close the opening. Make sure the stitches are small and very close together so nothing will escape.

Make a tag that lists all of the objects in the bag. Cover the tag with contact paper and punch a hole in one corner. Slip the list onto the ribbon. Tie a knot in the end so the list stays in place. Knead the bag to mix the objects into the pellets. **HAVE FUN!!!**

## Tangram

Make a copy of the tangram pattern on cardstock. Cut the pattern into 7 pieces along the solid lines. The pieces are manipulated to form different objects. Follow these patterns and then create some patterns of your own.



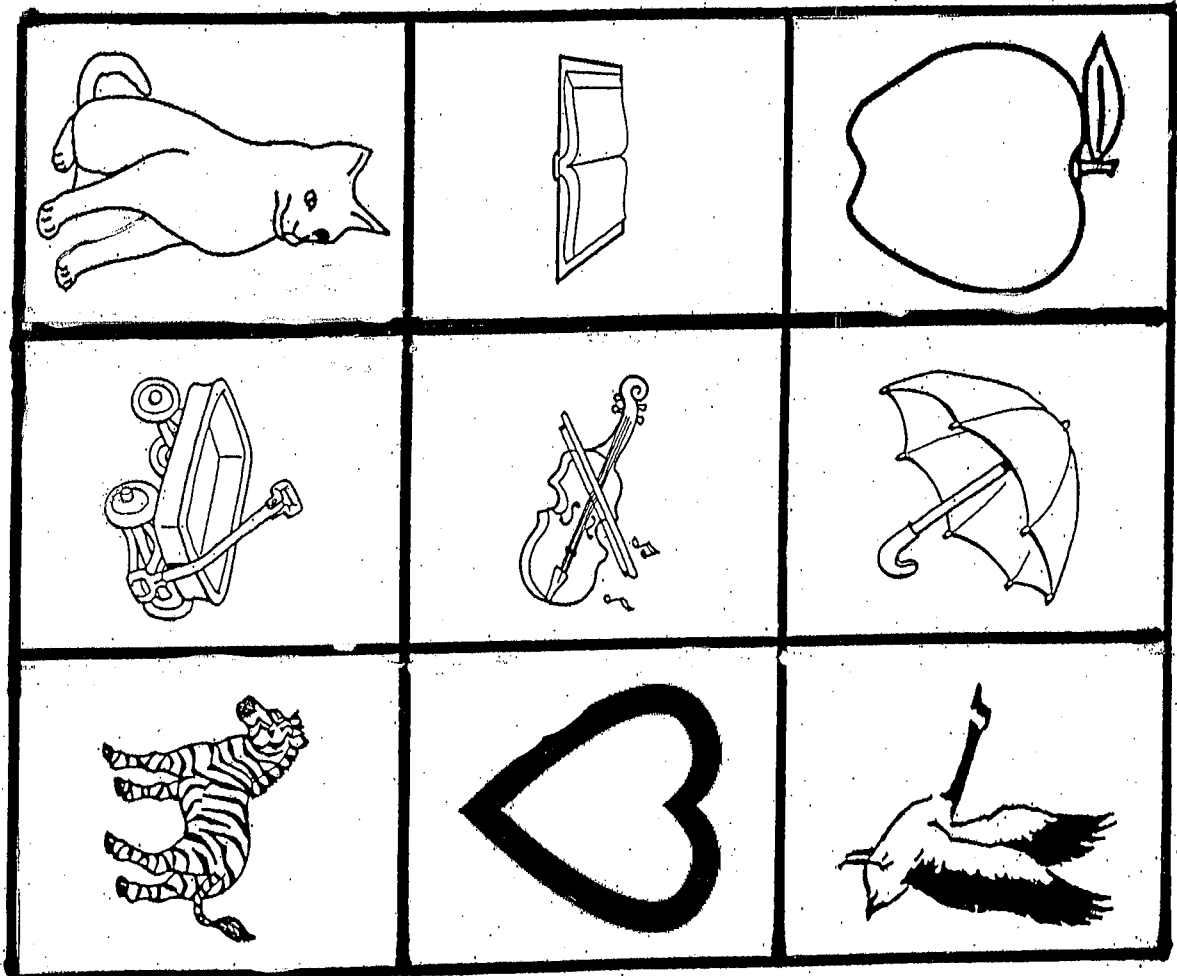
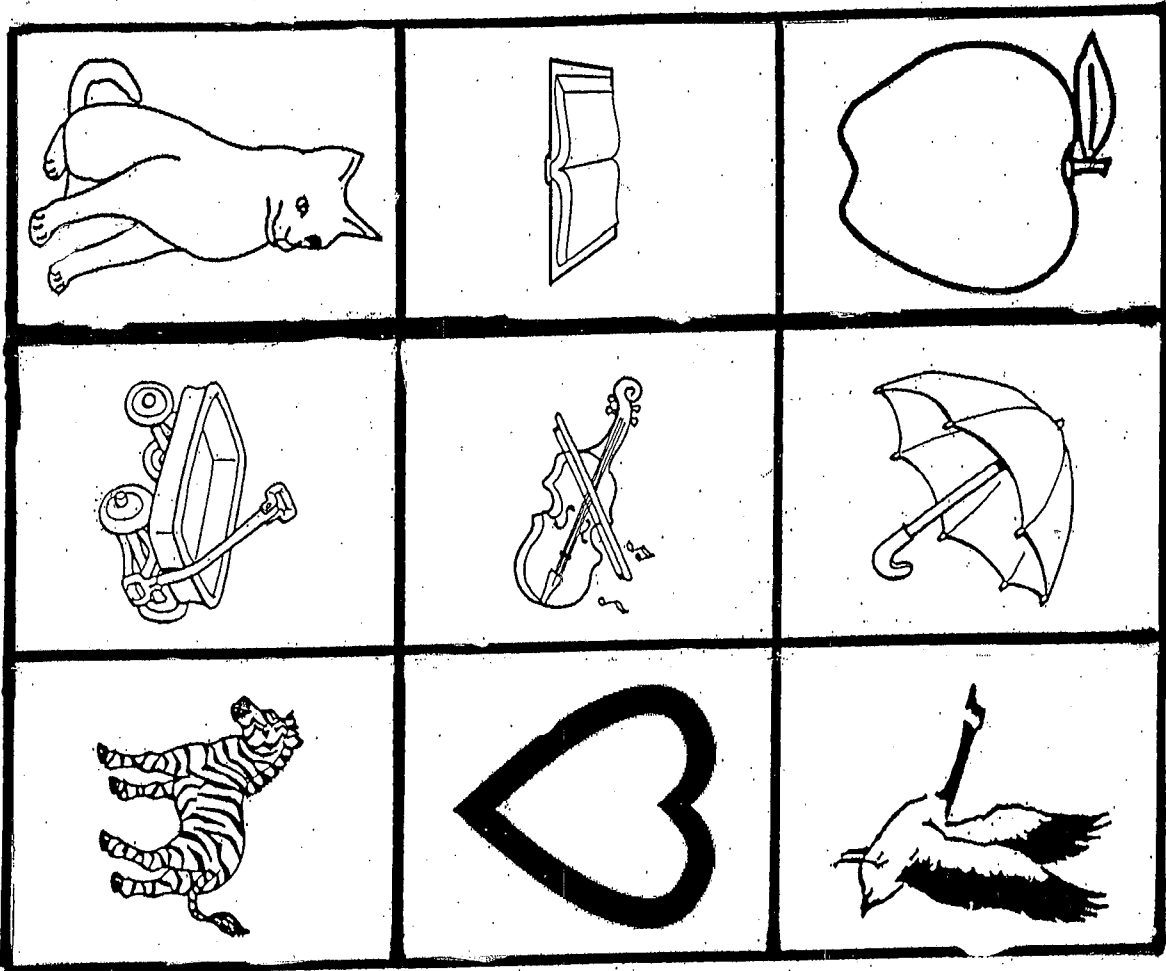


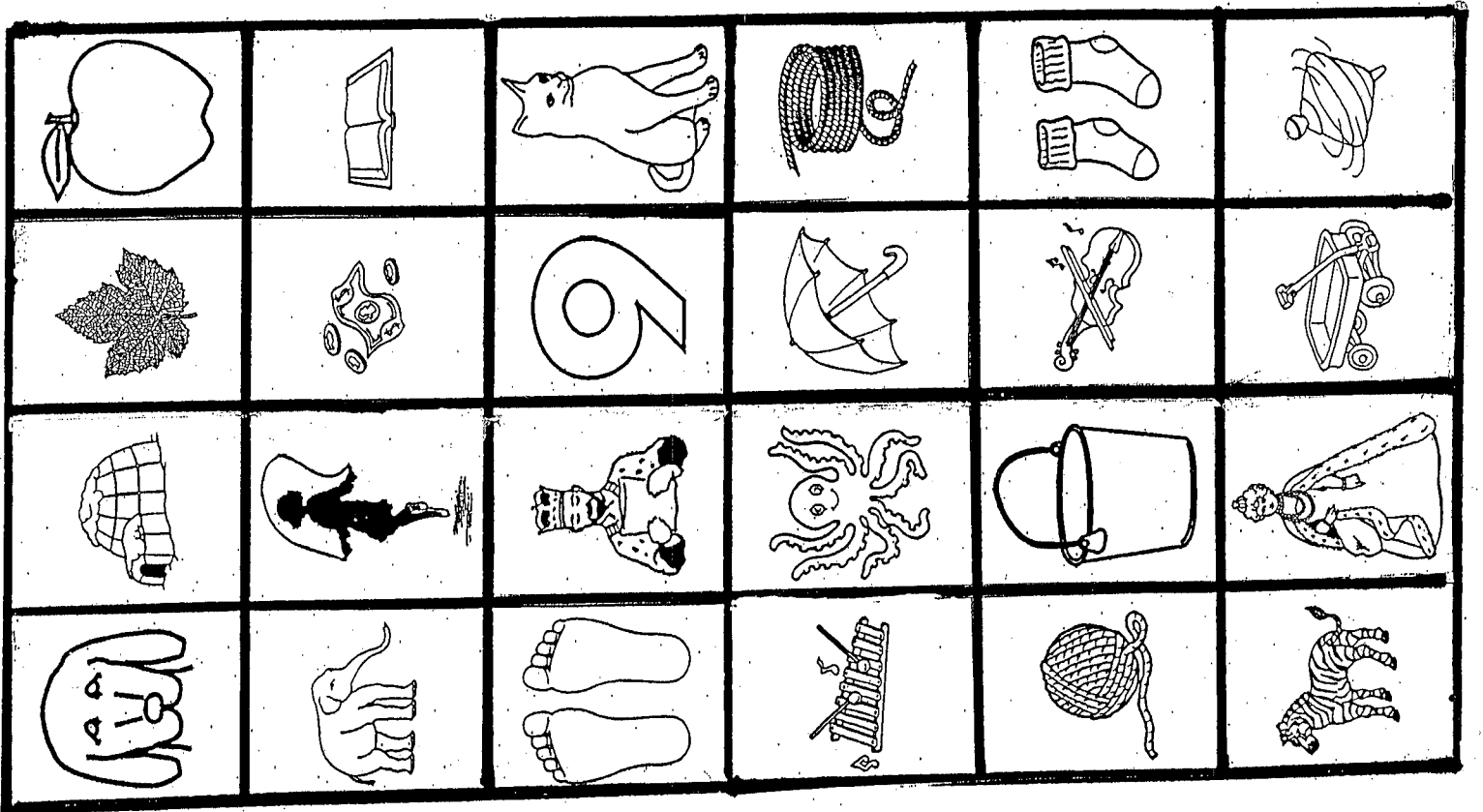
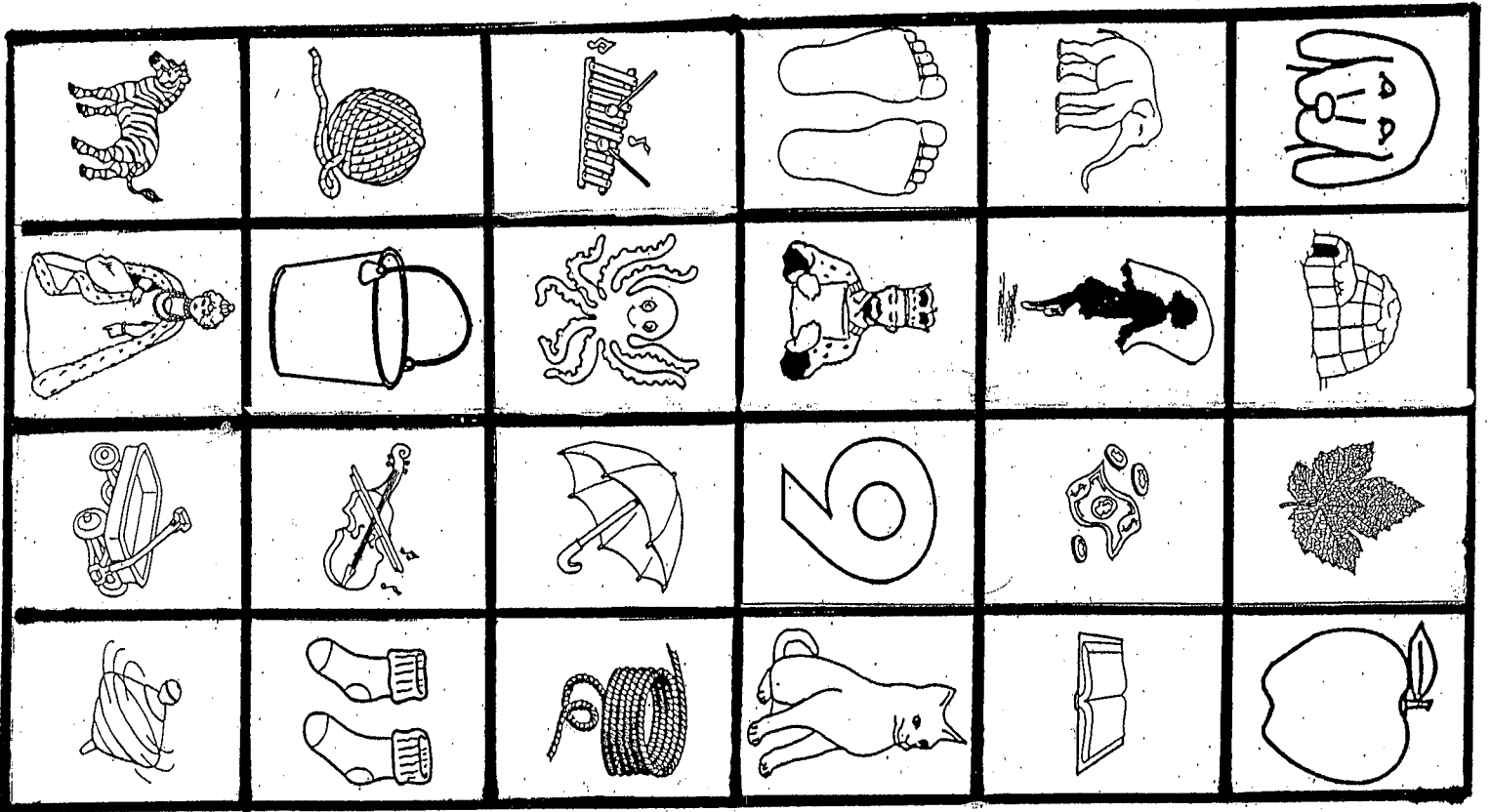
## Memory Game

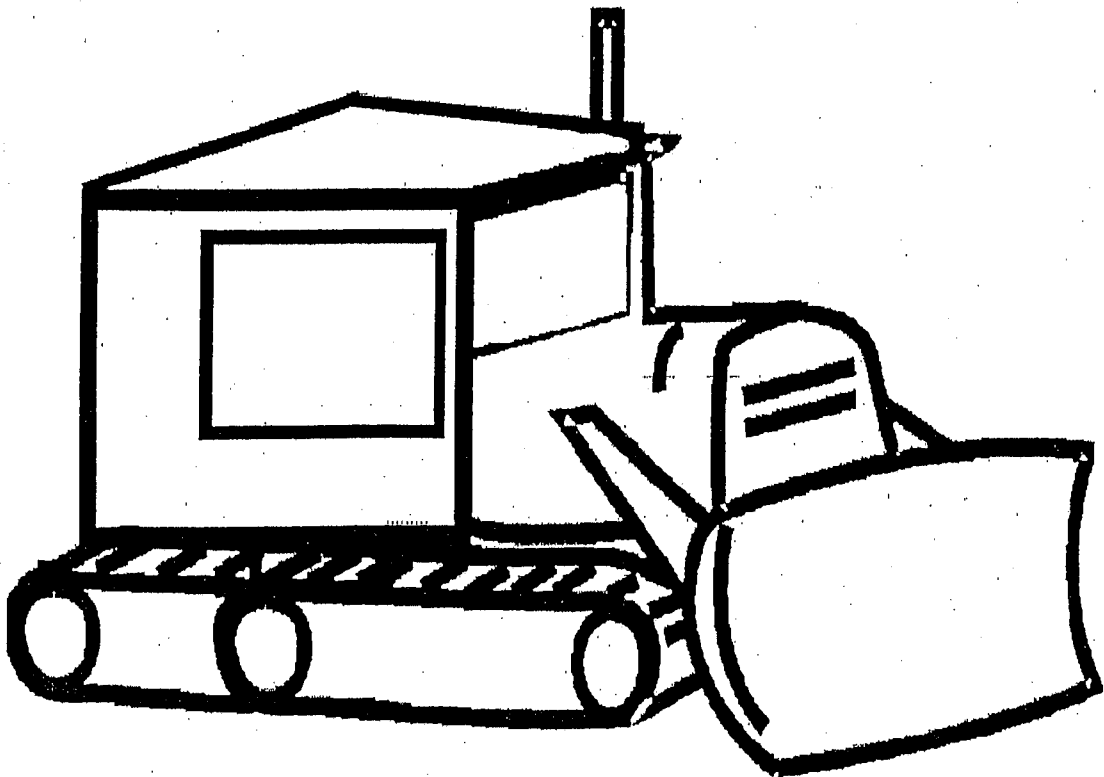
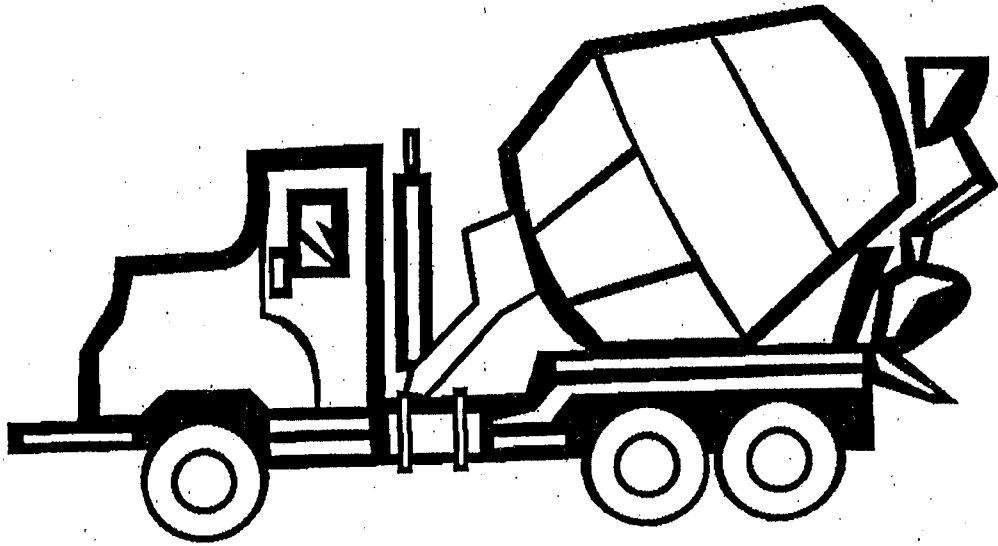
Copy the memory game grid onto cardstock. Color each set of game pieces so they are identical. Cover the game with contact paper to make it more sturdy. Cut out the sets. To play the game, place all pieces face down on a table. Take turns picking up two pieces. If they match, keep them and take another turn. If they do not match, turn them face down again and the next player takes a turn.

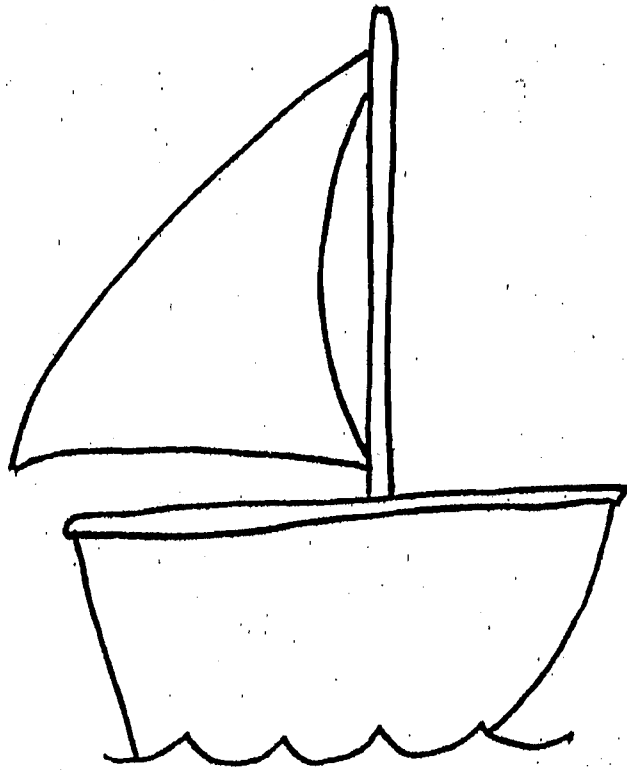
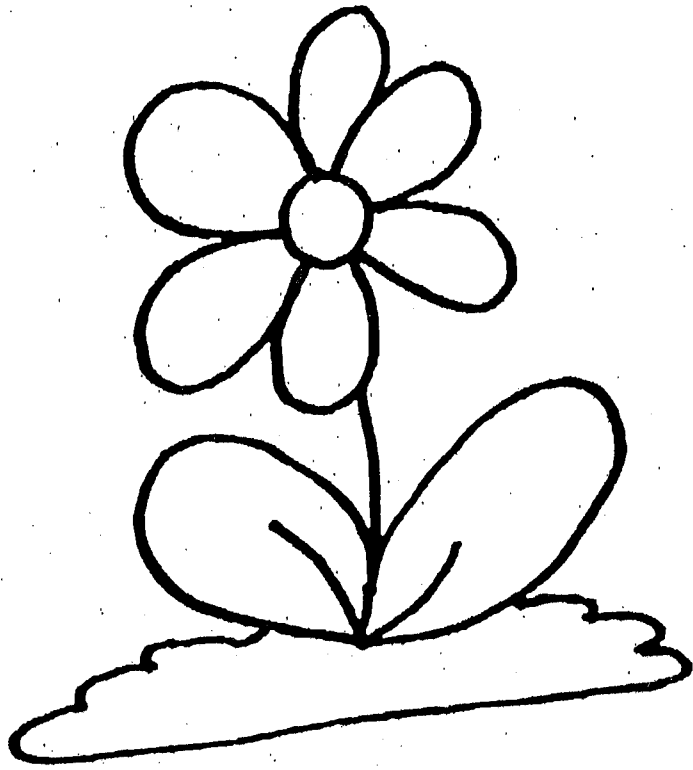
## Lacing Card

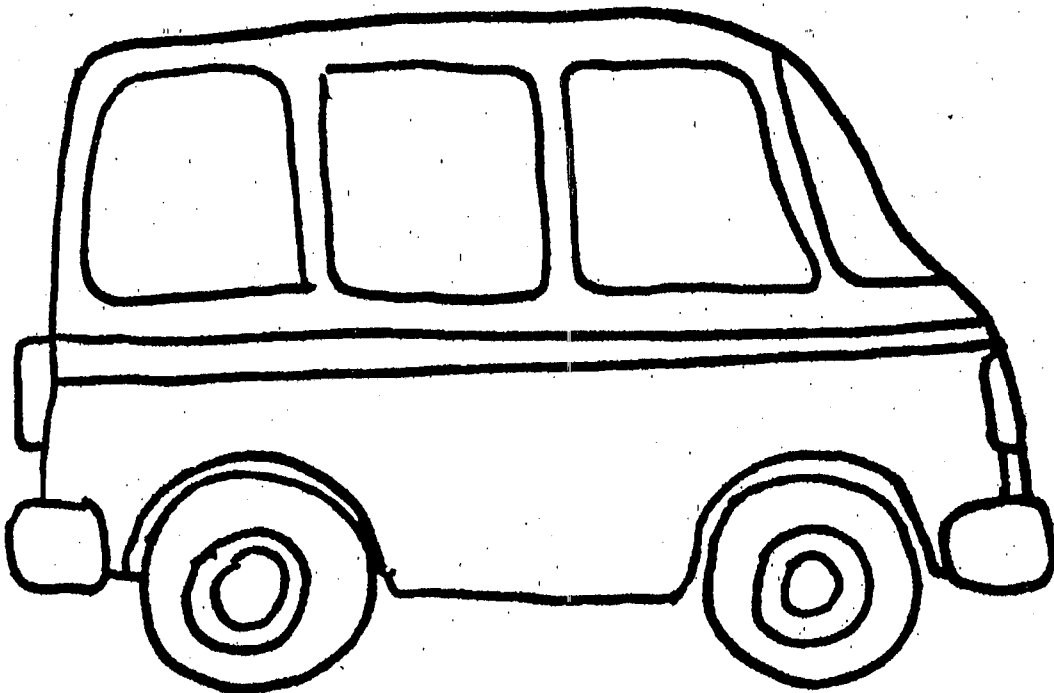
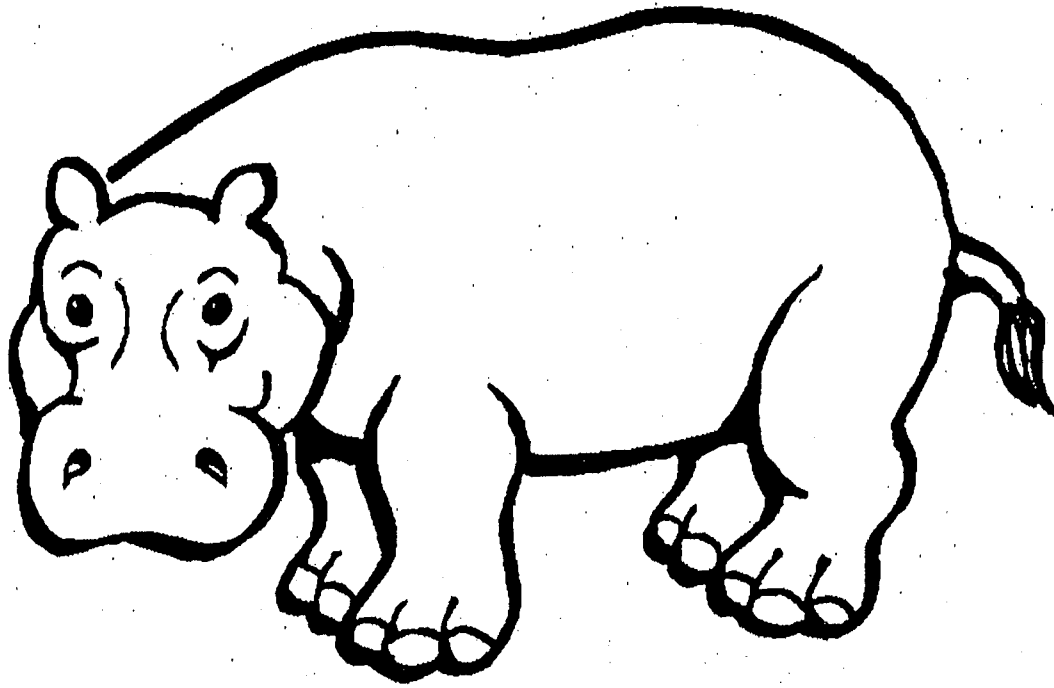
The ice cream cone is a lacing card. Copy the pieces onto different colors of cardstock. Cover with contact paper to make it more sturdy. Cut the pieces out and punch holes as indicated on the pattern. Use a shoe lace, a piece of yarn, etc. as the lace. Start in one corner of the cone and lace the edge of the cone. Then add each scoop of ice cream until you top it off with a cherry!

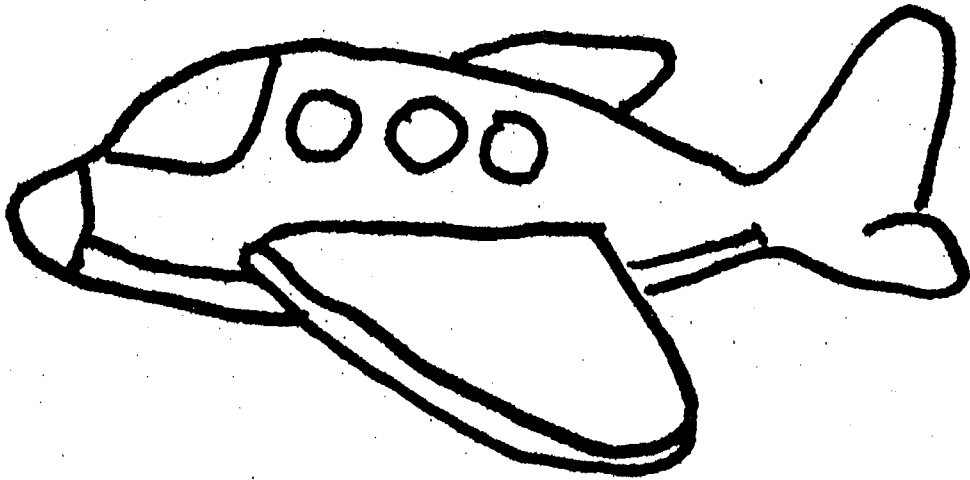
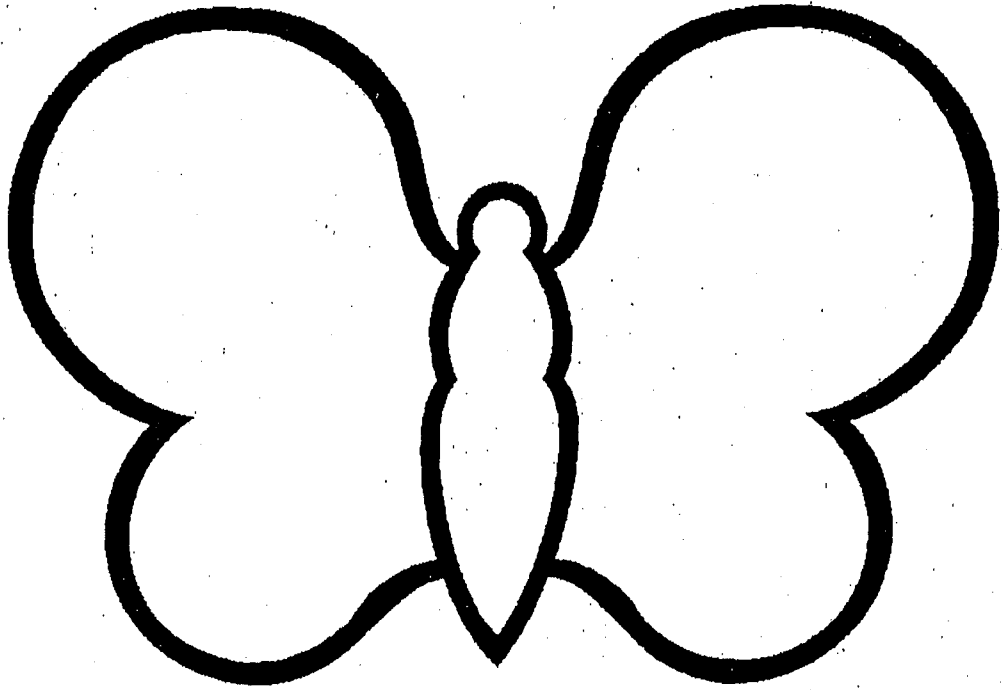


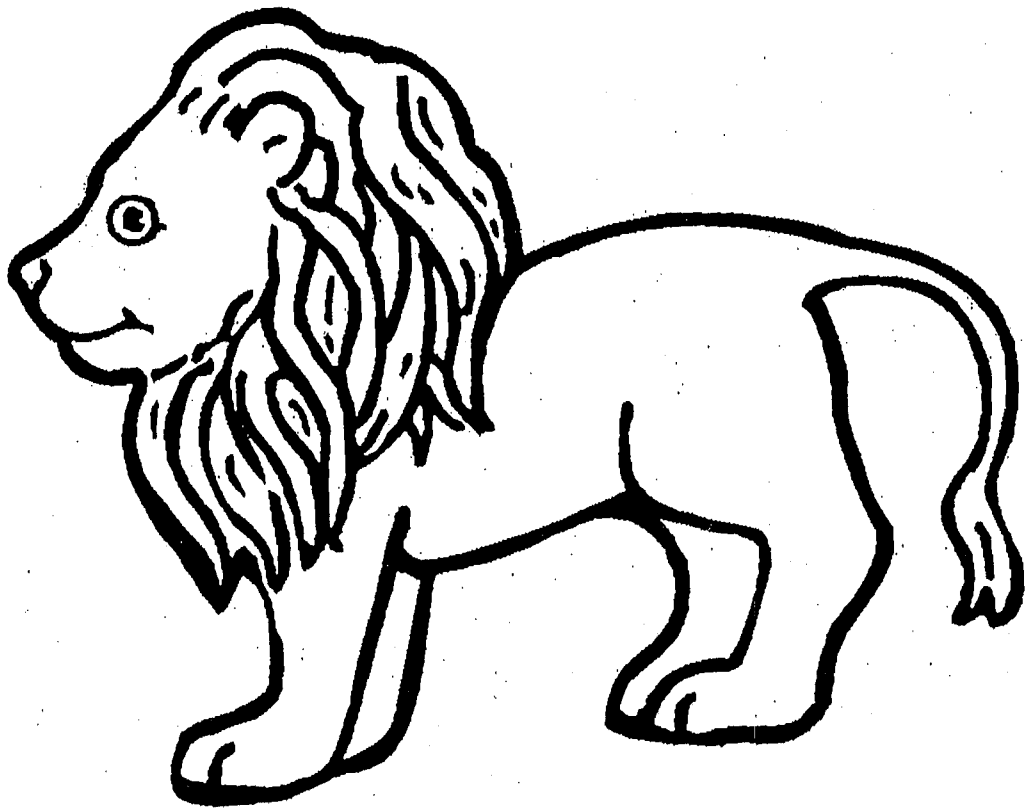
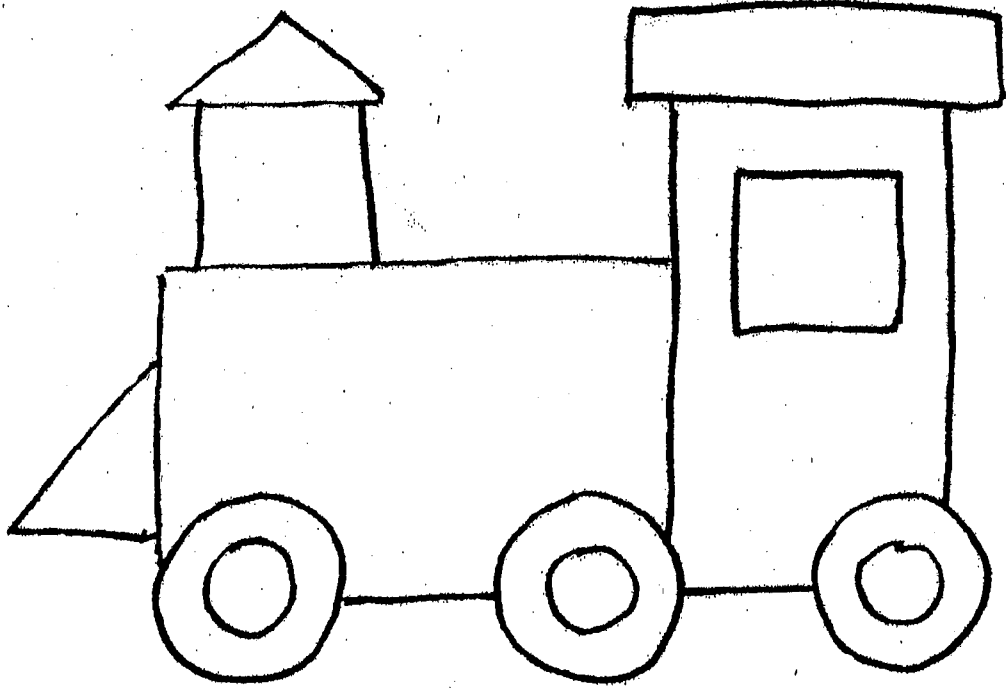


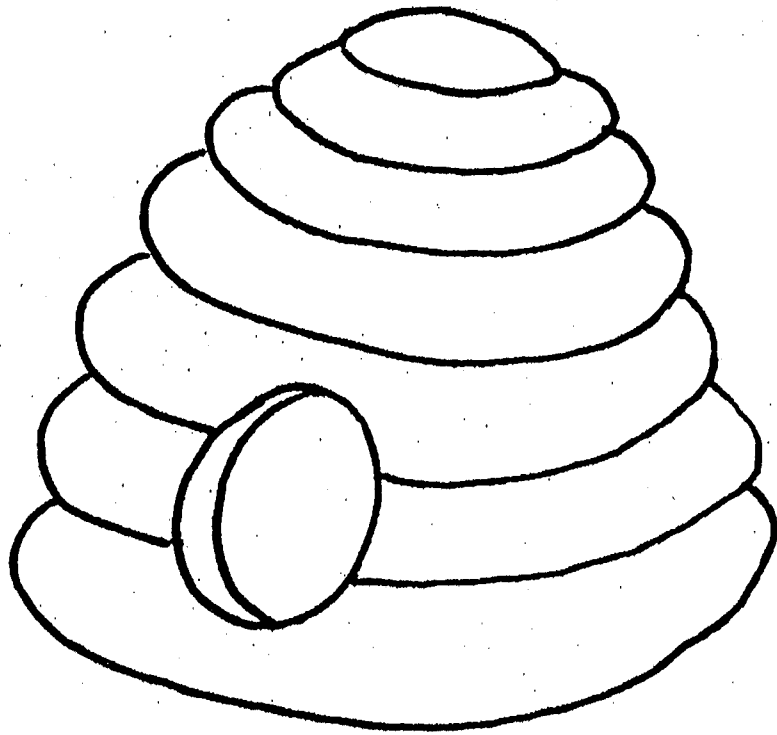


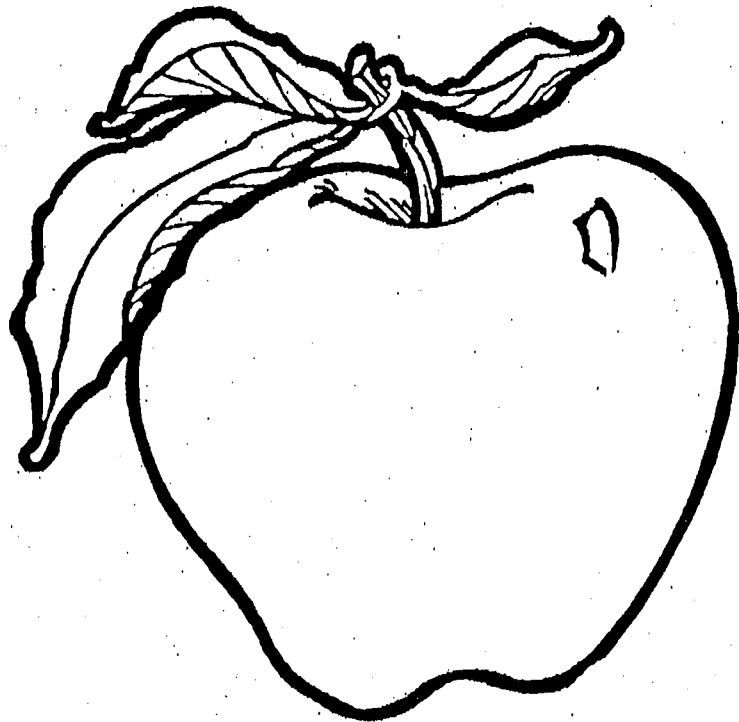
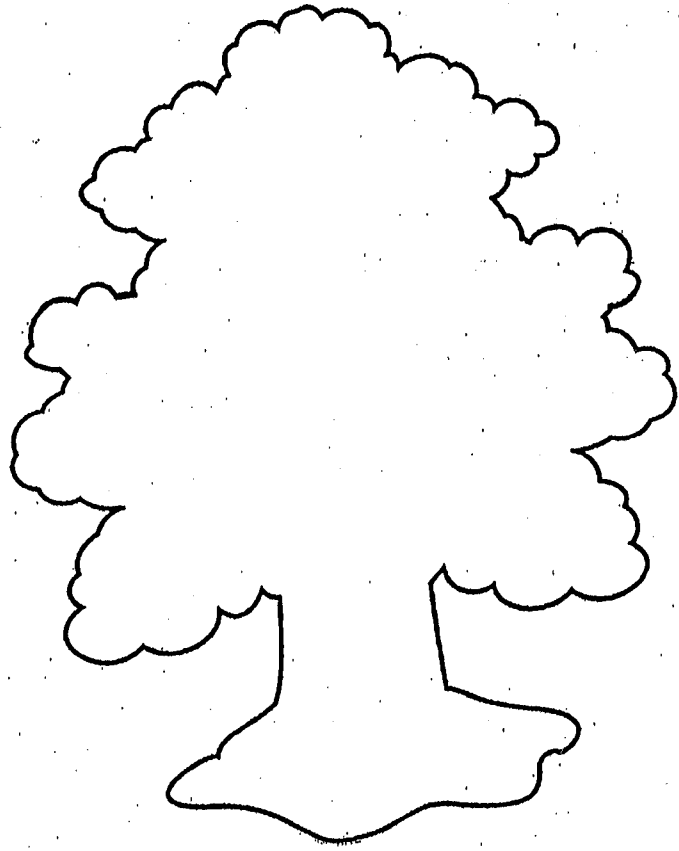


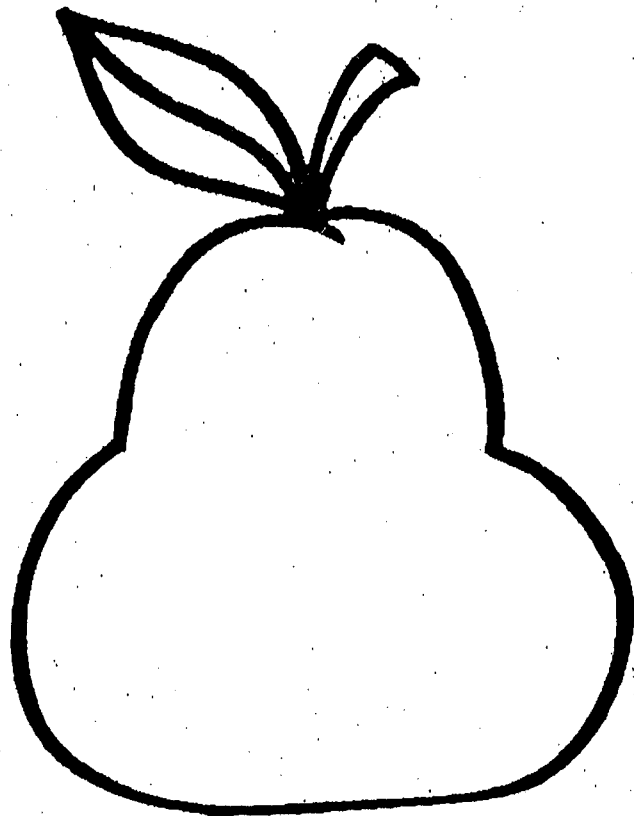
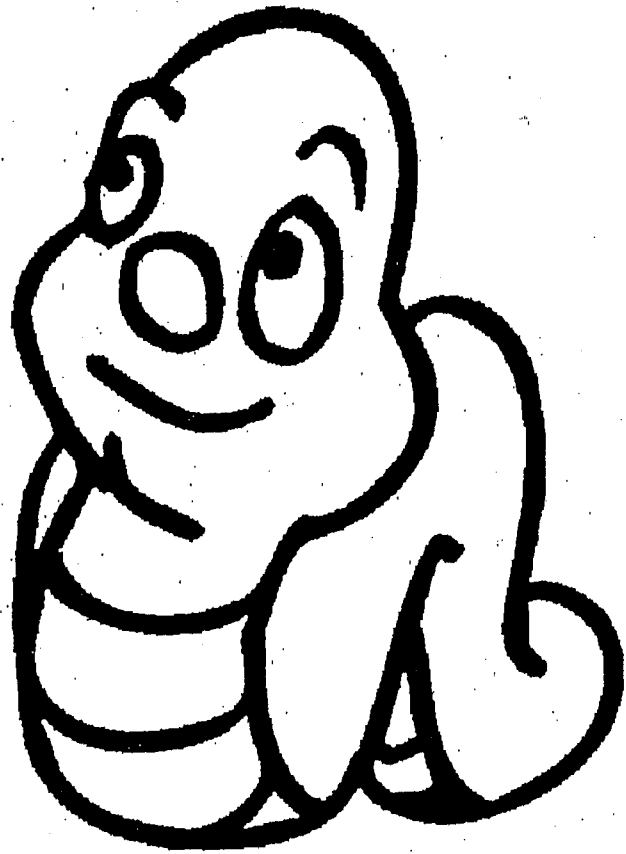


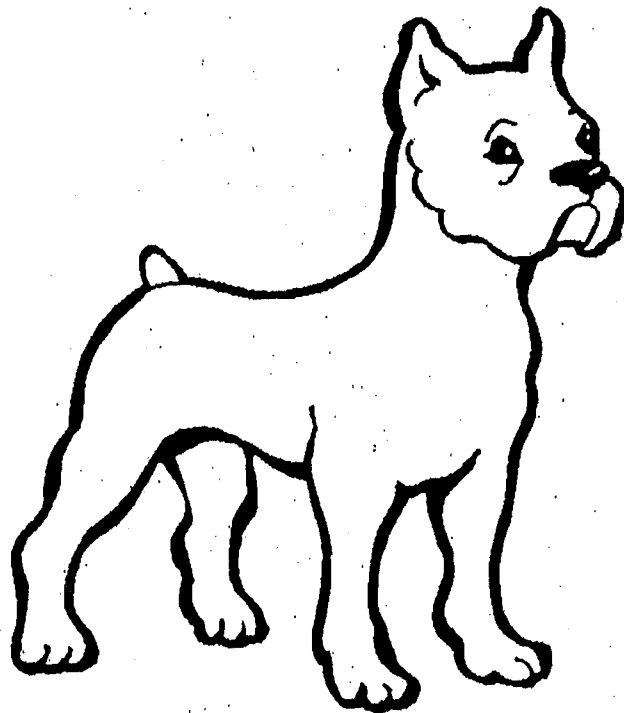
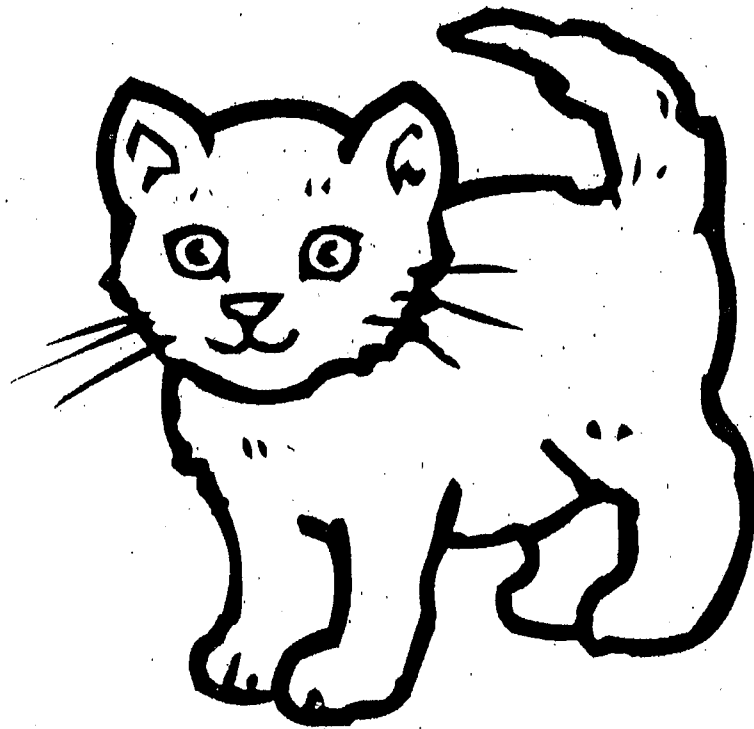


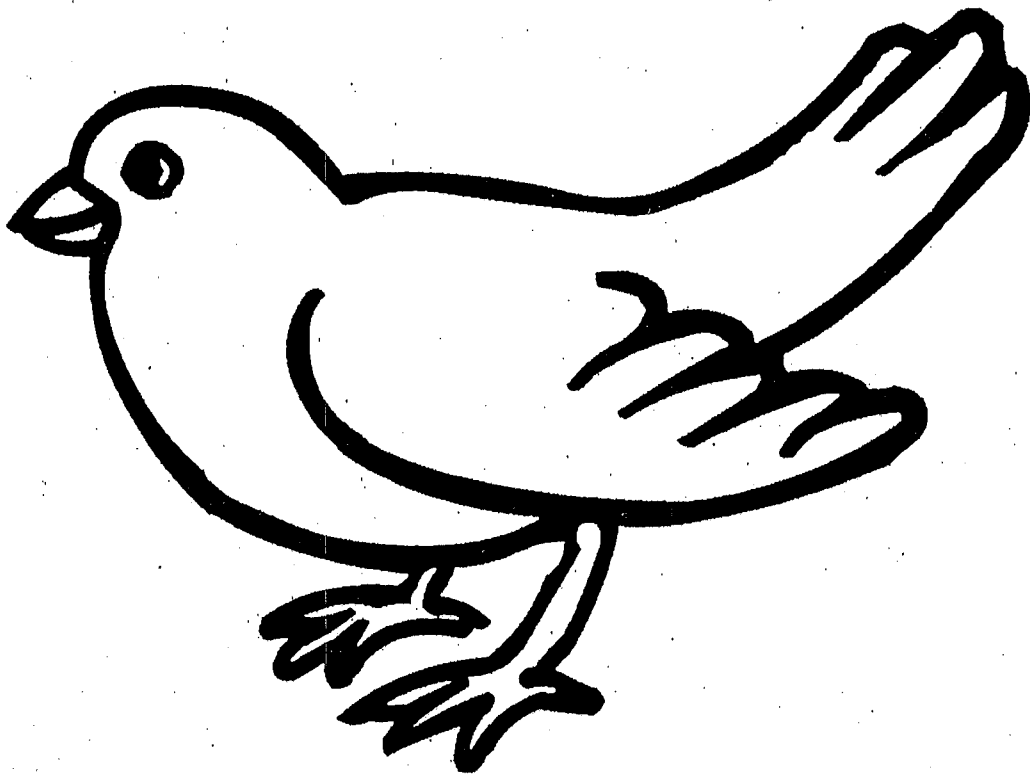
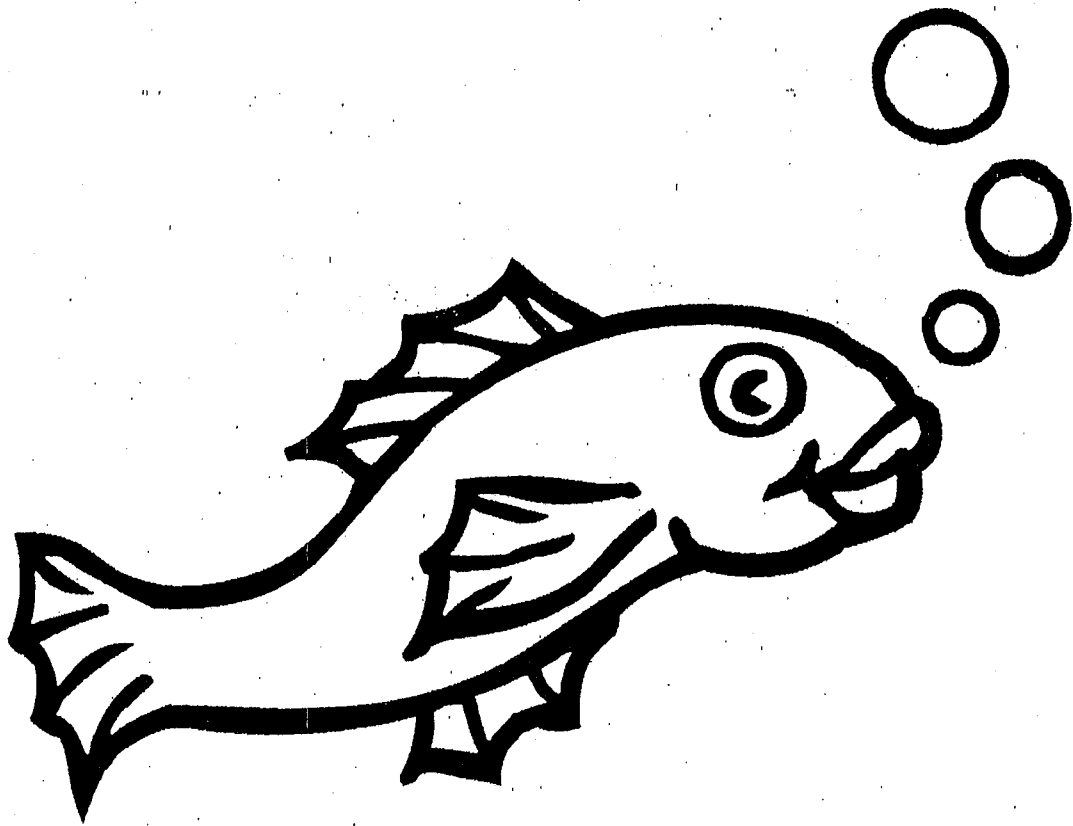


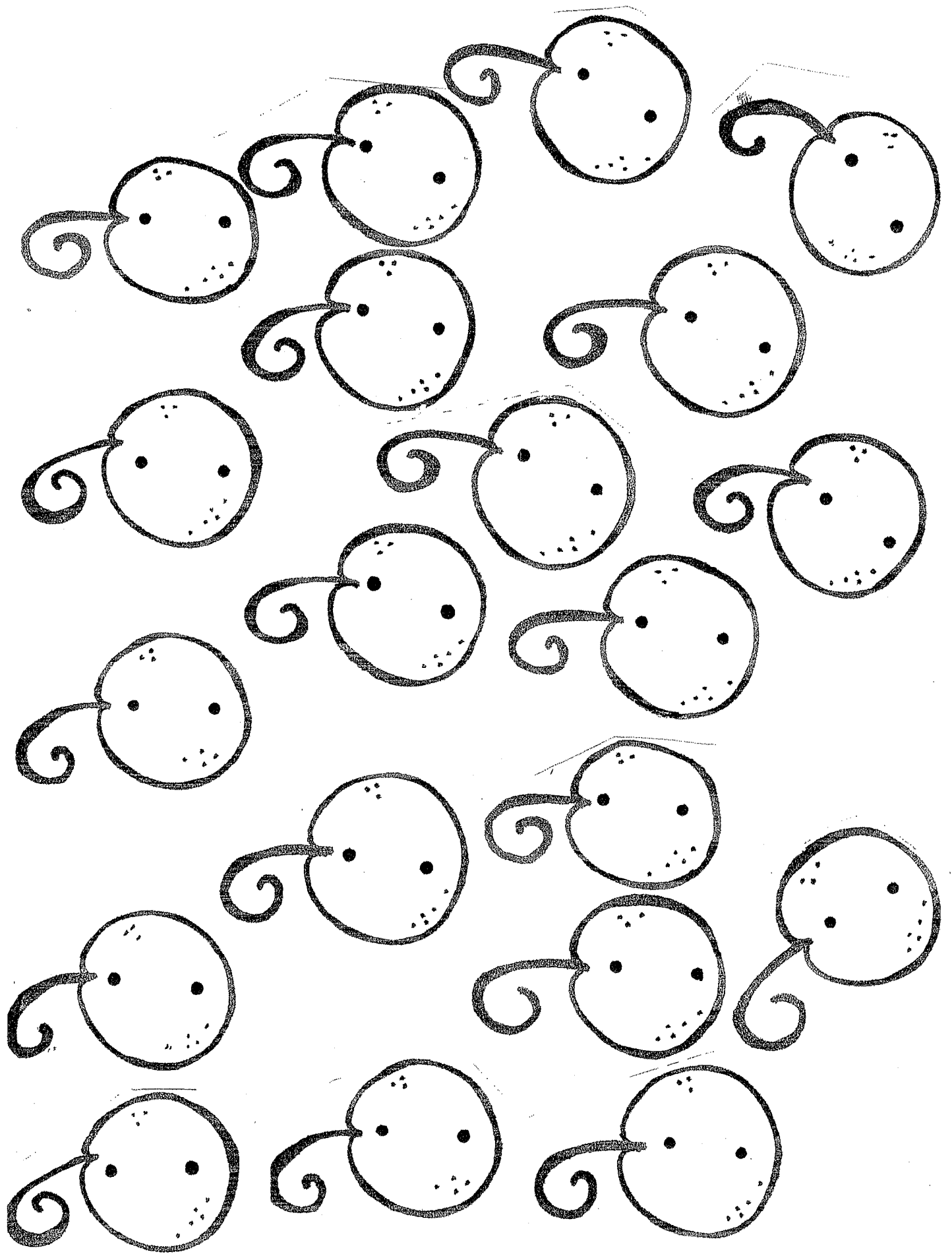


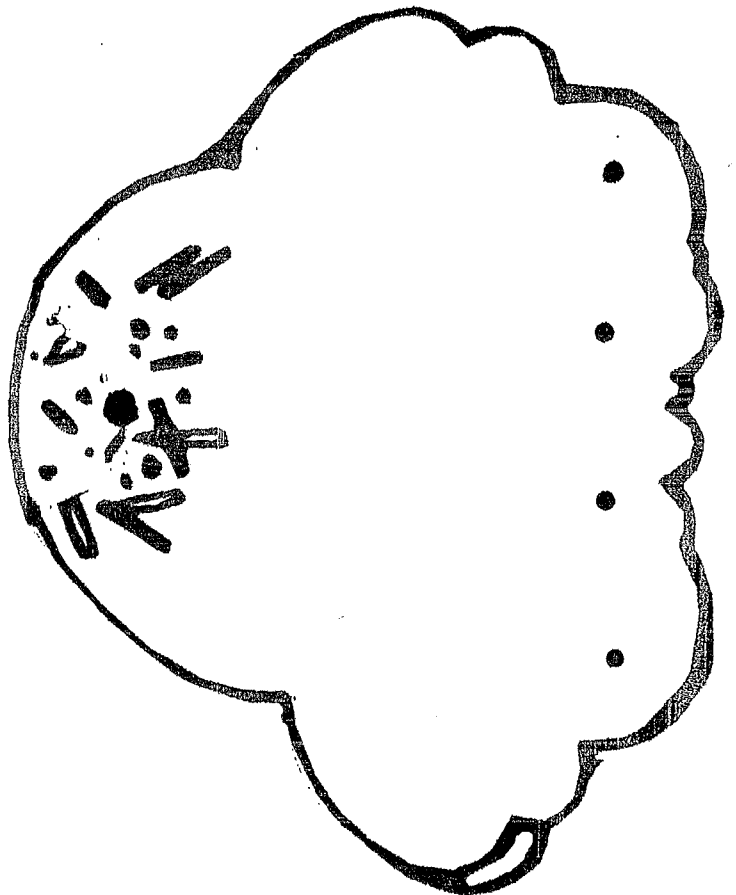
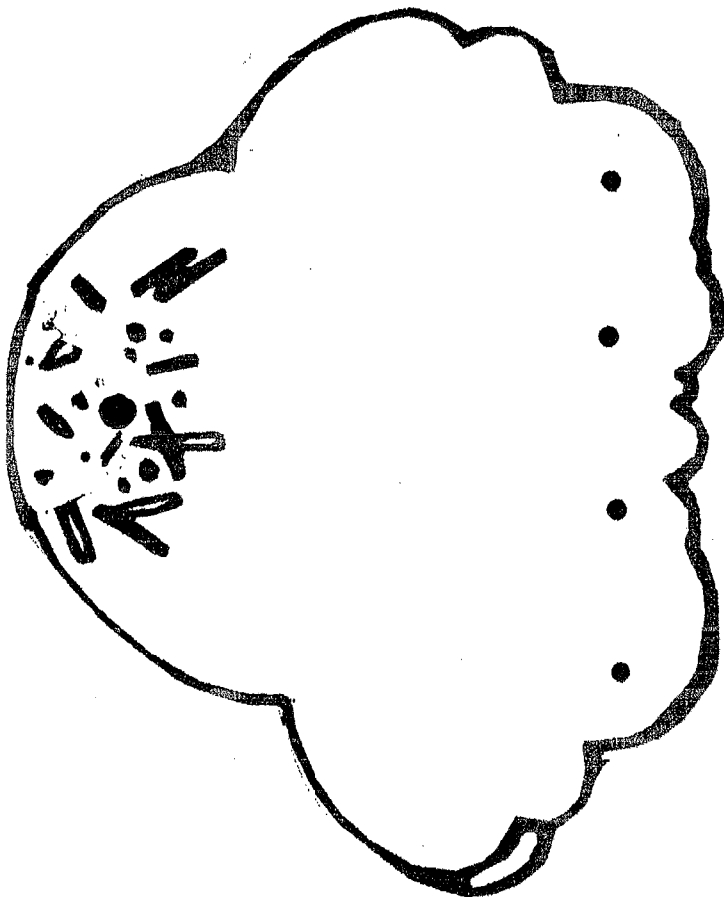
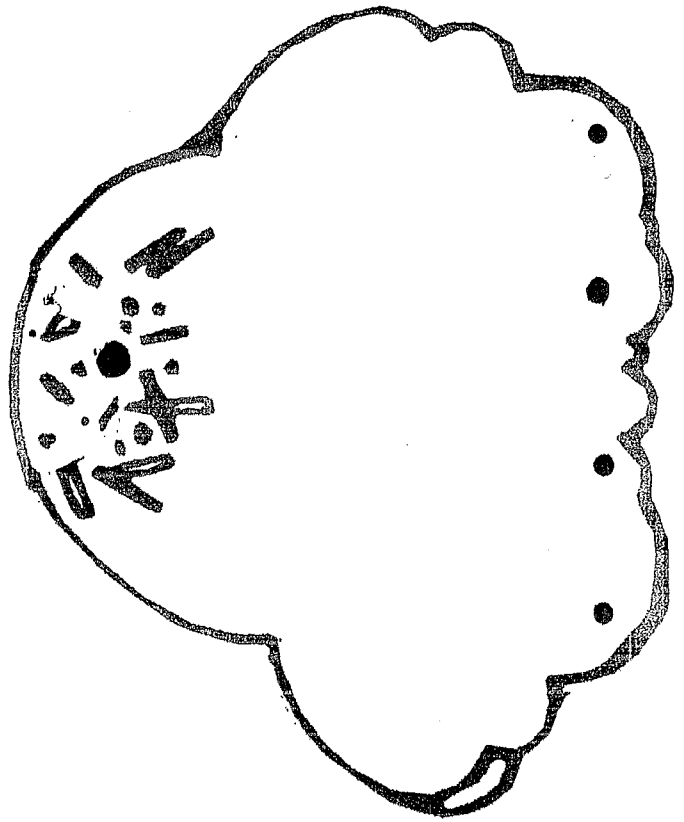
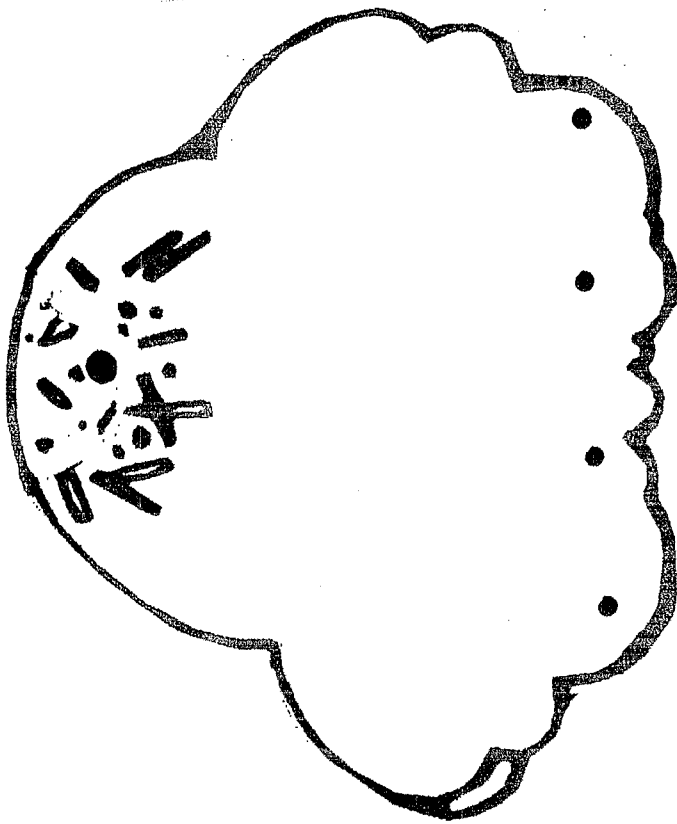


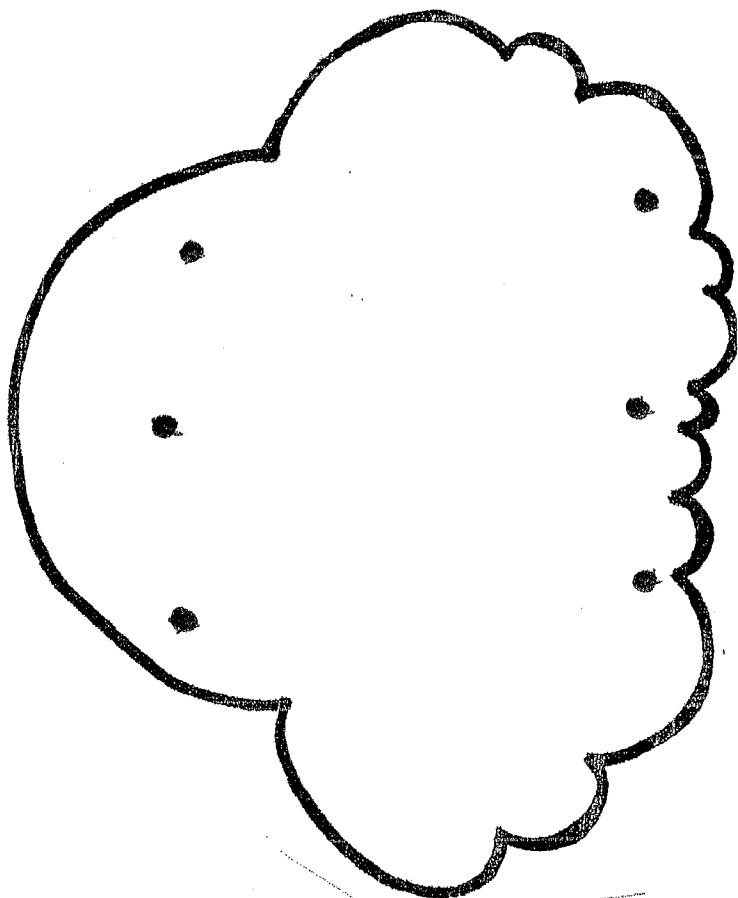
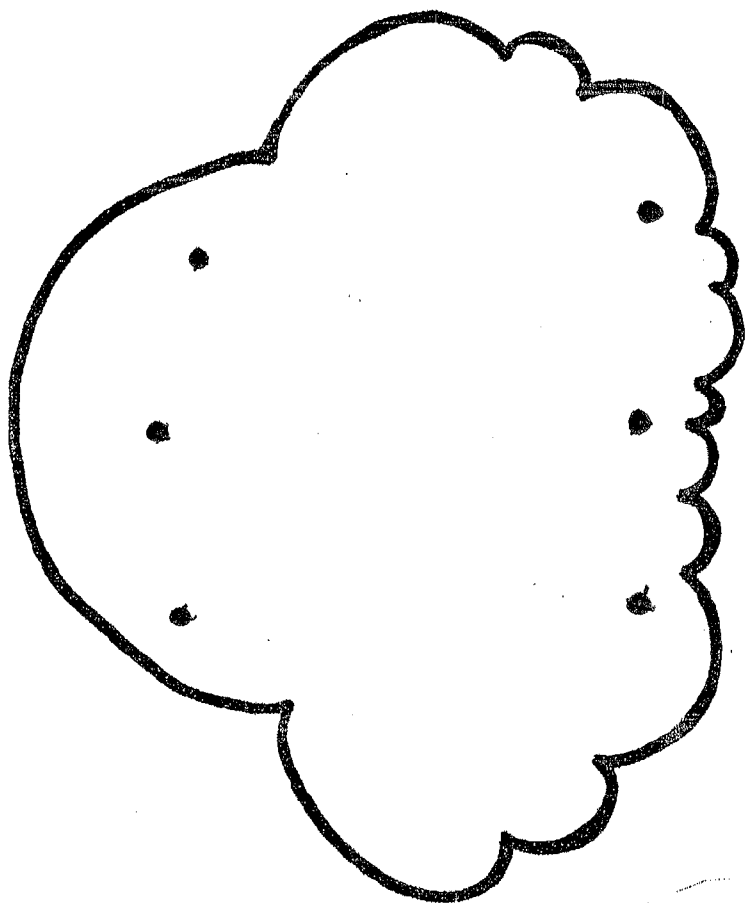
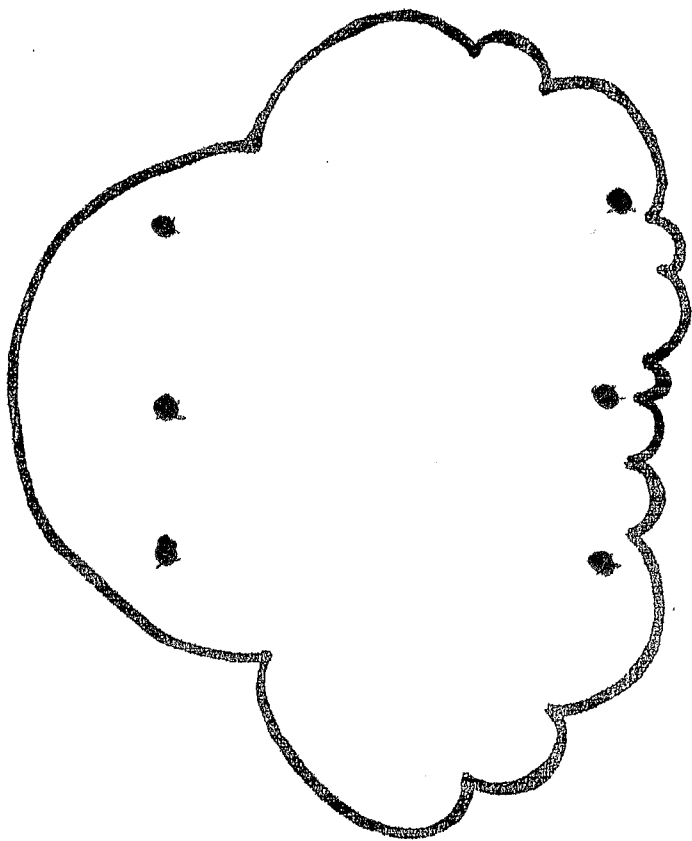
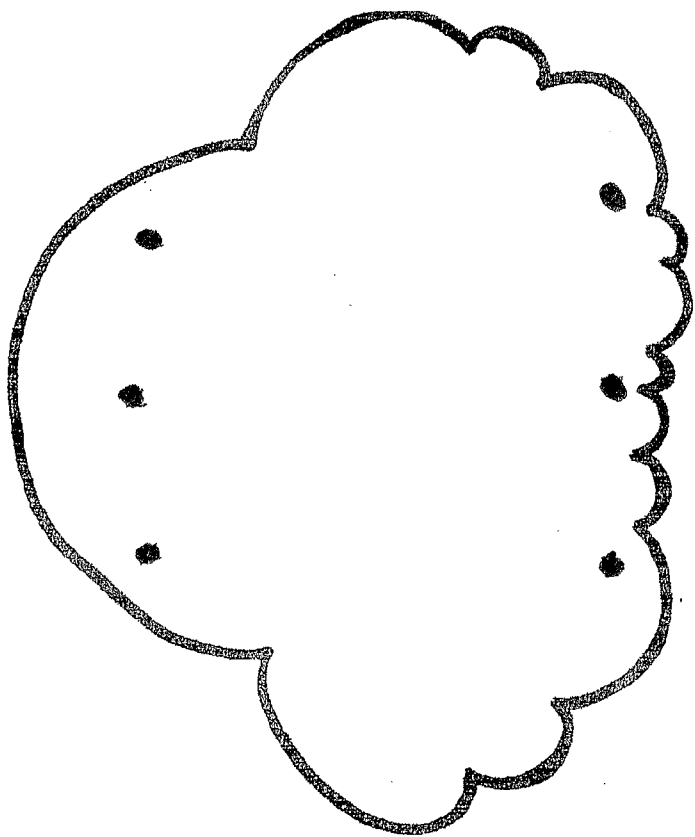


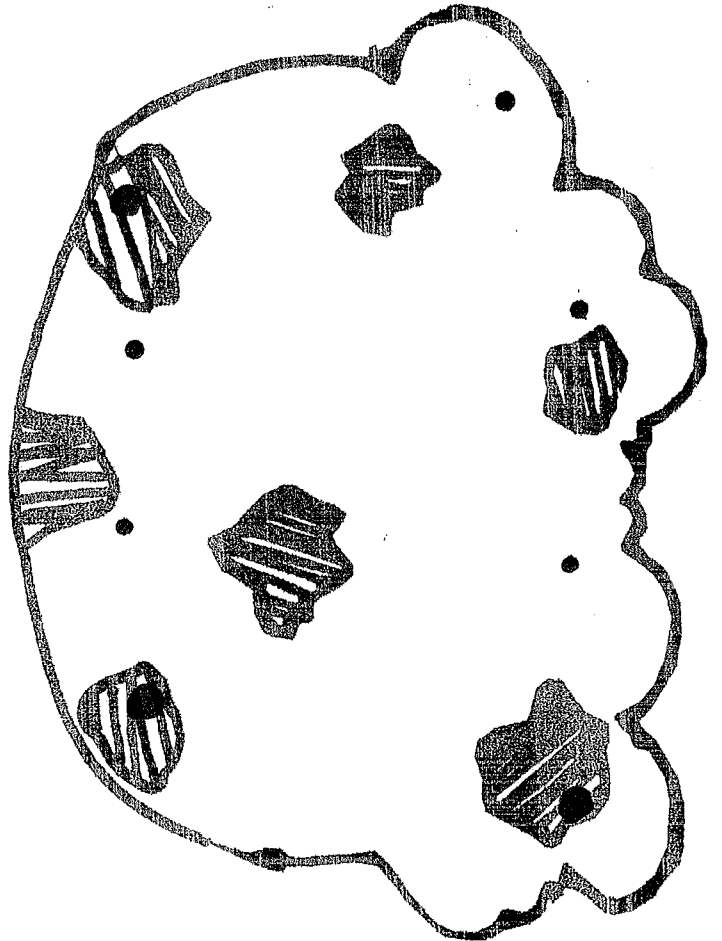
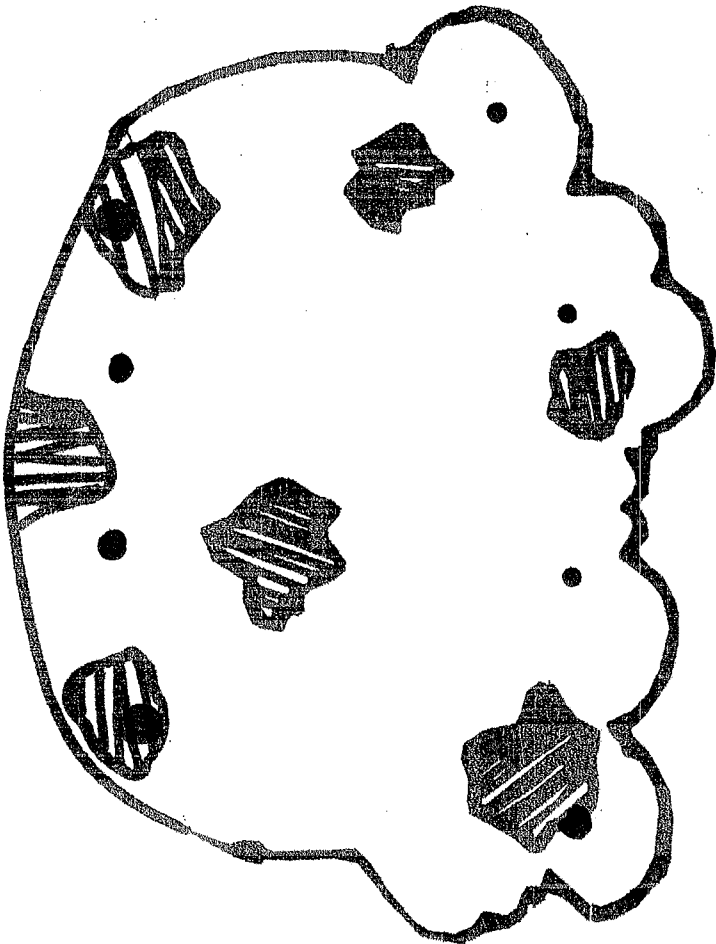
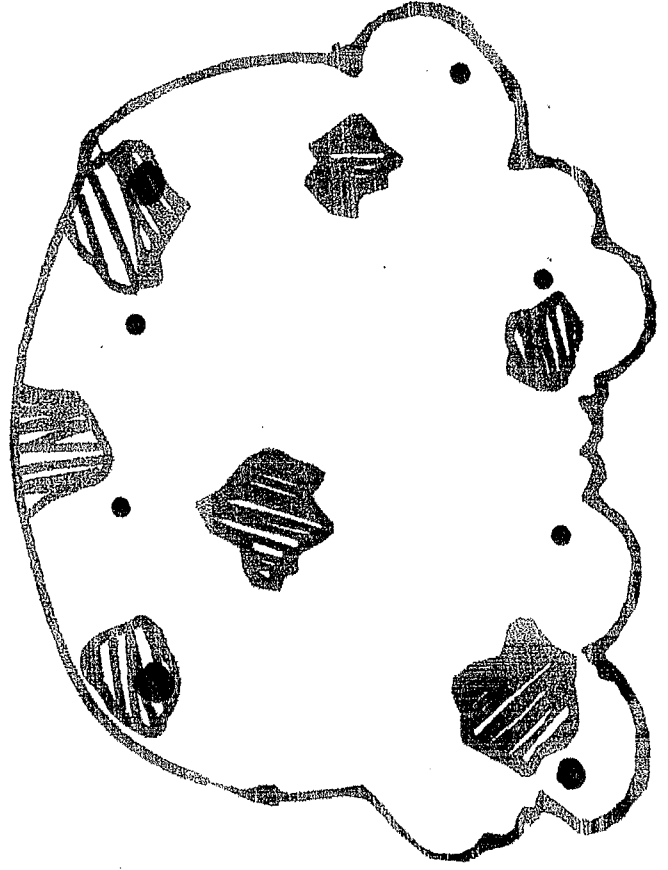
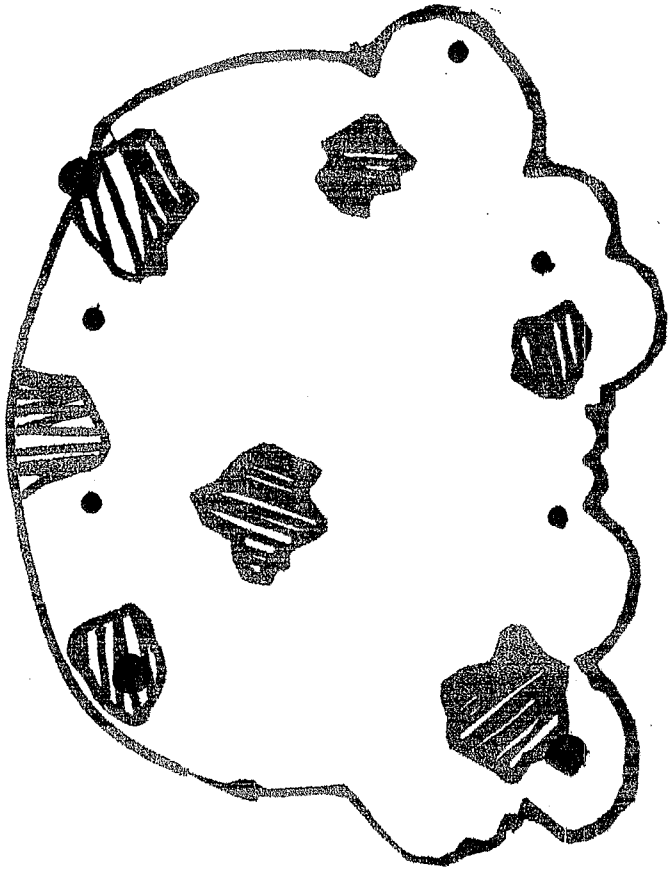


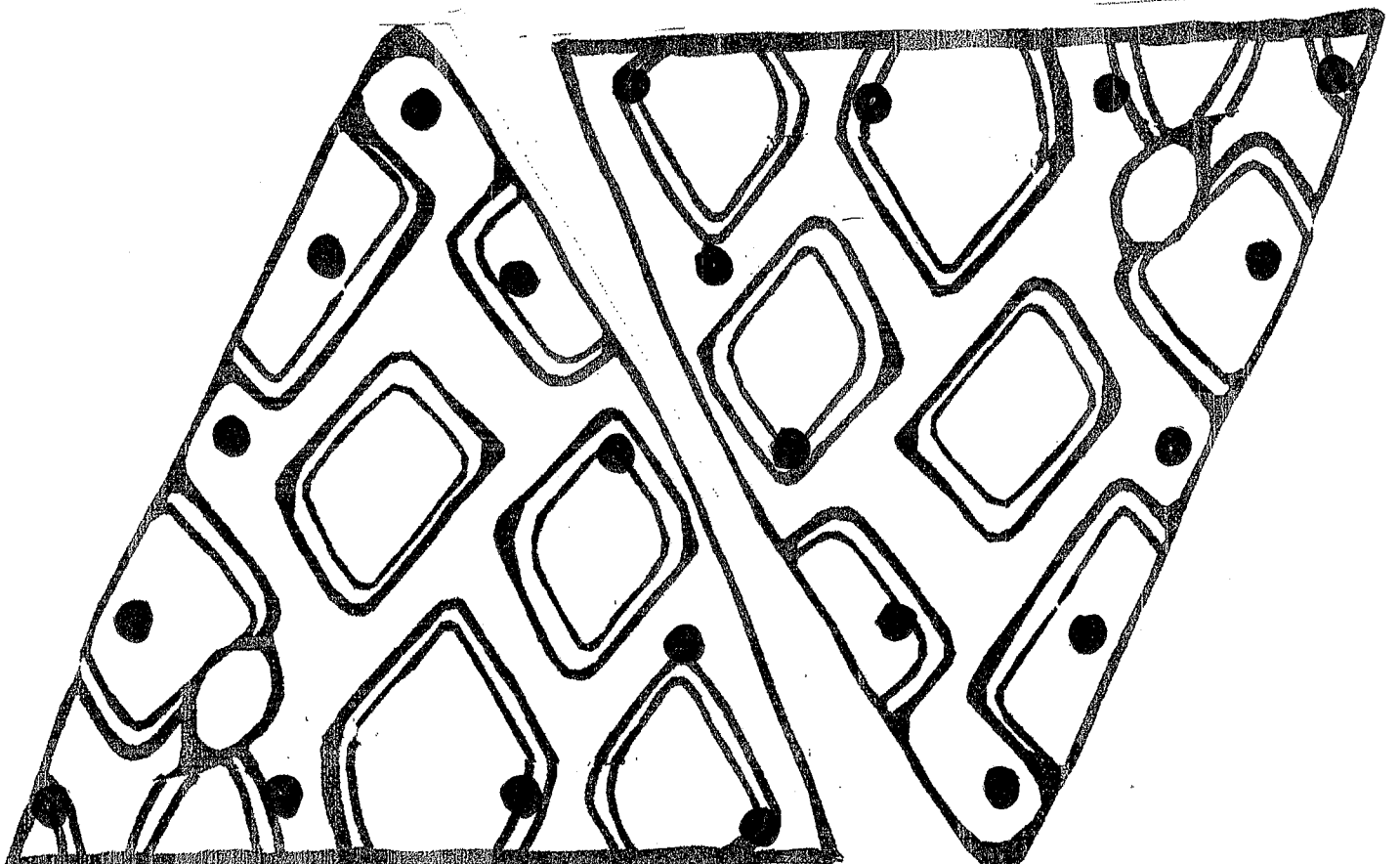
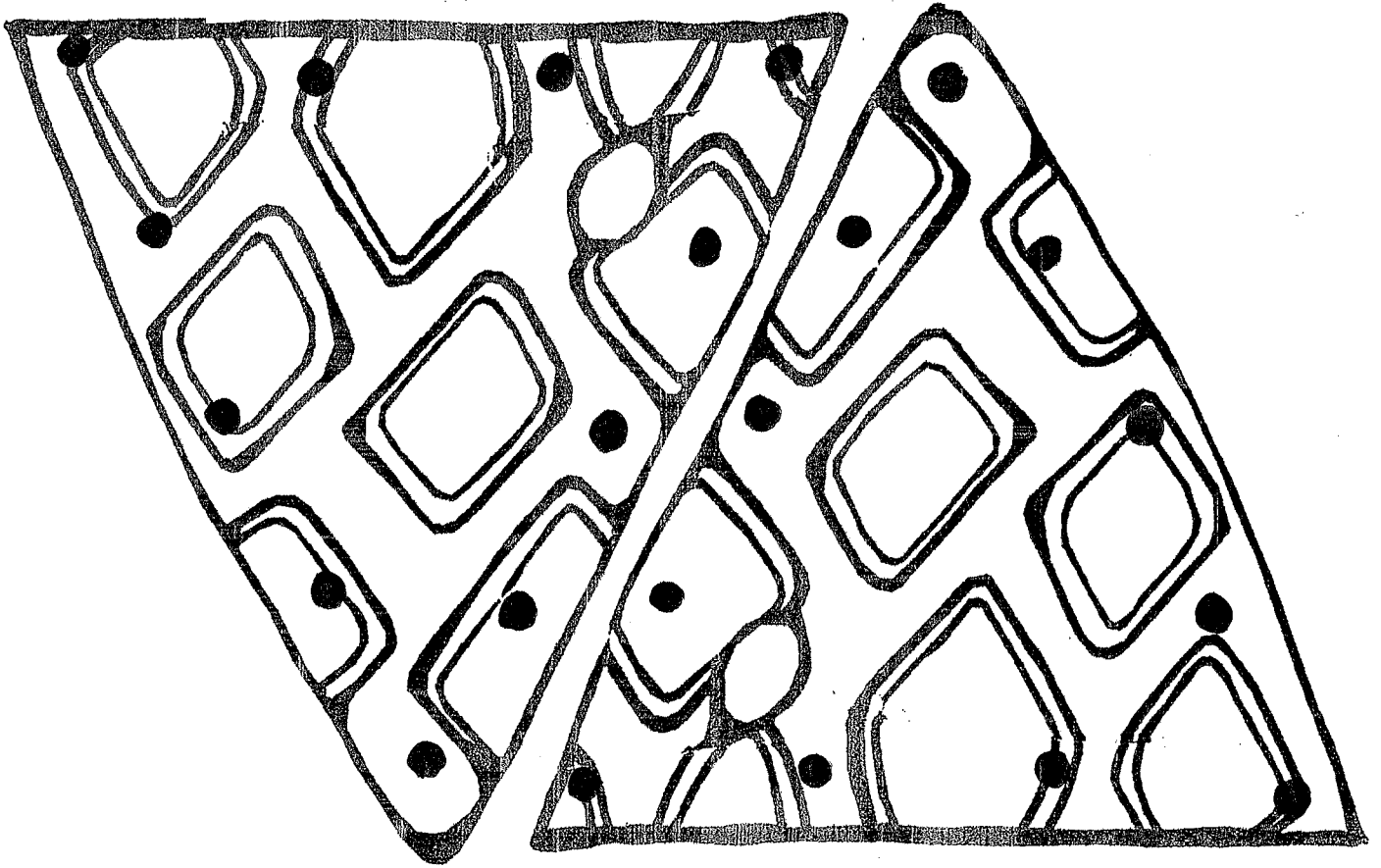
