- (2) Miter, dowel, or mortise and tenon joints

Then build this project and show it to your counselor. Use the back of this page to describe what you did.

*Option 2:*

Make something for which you have to turn duplicate parts on a lathe. Show it to your counselor and describe it on the back of this page.

*Option 3:*

Make a cabinet, box, or something else with a door or lid fastened with inset hinges. Show your project to your counselor and use the back of this page to describe how you made it.

*Option 4:*

Help make and repair wooden toys for underprivileged children **OR** help carry out a carpentry service project approved by your counselor for a charitable organization. Use the back of this page to describe what you did and your experience with it.
