



Shape Maker

Materials needed: A thin rope about 10 feet long.

Instructions:

Take a thin rope about 10 feet long and tie the ends together. The participants each grab a section of the rope. Instruct them to make different shapes with the rope, as exact as they can. (ie: a square, a circle, a triangle, a heart, a diamond, etc.) Tell the participants to drop the rope and blindfold them. This time while blindfolded, instruct them again to grab a section of the rope and make different shapes out of it.

Discussion:

- 👉 What was the difference between making shapes with and without the blindfold?
- 👉 What did the blindfolds do to your mode of communication, how did you improvise or change your communication?
